

4th 'Prolife World Congress' in Saragossa

Sensitization: a symphony for life
6th to 8th of November 2009
Saragossa, Spain



The theme of the congress: 'Sensitization: a symphony for life', will be tackled from the medical, juridical, political, ethical and anthropological point of view.

We count with the presence of international speakers such as: **Paola Binetti**, directors of the Department for Educational and Didactic Investigation of Campus Biomédico of Rome; **Ramón Lucas Lucas**, Professor of philosophical and bioethical Anthropology, Gregorian University of Rome; **Alejandro Leal Esquivel**, Professor of Human genetics, School of Biology and Program of Investigation in Neurscience of the University of Costa Rica; **Maria Concepción Morales Peralta**, Internist, president of Prolife Cuba; **Anna Záborská**, president of the Commission of Rights of Woman and Equality of Gender in the European Parliament; **Carlo Casini**, president of Movimento Per la Vita (Italy); **Julia Regina de Cardenal**, president of the Foundation Yes to Life, (El Salvador); **Richard Stith**, professor of Law at Valparaiso University (US); **Aurelio García Elorrio**, president of "The portal of Bethlehem ", Cordova (Argentina); **Marijo Zivkovic**, president of the Prolife Movement, Zagreb (Croatia); **Benjamín Correa**, member of the World Front of parliamentarians for life and the family, (Chile); **Martin Ssempe**, promoter of the implantation of the ABC method in Uganda; and **John Smeaton**, president of The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (UK), among others.

The congress is a task of the permanent council of the Prolife World Congress organized on behalf of the Spanish Federation of Prolife Groups by the Aragon Prolife Association. The number of assistants will be approximately one thousand. The president of the congress, Dr. Álvaro Vázquez, has told that the target " is to sensitize every body with the fact that life is the most valued gift that we have" and that " in the protection of each and everyone human being in each and everyone of his phases of development resides the wellbeing of society ".



Why should you come to Saragossa?

- To learn from others and to share yours and their experiences about strategies, initiatives, resources, and lobbying on behalf of the prolife cause.
- To detect new and successful approaches to help society to become aware of the value of life.
- To defend the right of mothers, particularly young mothers, to carry on with their pregnancy with the help of society as a whole and of governments in particular.
- To gather information to foster sound medical research and to stop the traffic and destruction of human embryos.
- The congress will also serve as a venue for national prolife leaders to discuss and agree on common prolife policies at international level.

Building a global network in defense of life

The previous Prolife World Congresses were held in Madrid, in 2003 (where it was agreed to celebrate on March 25 the Day of Life); in Lima (Peru), in 2005; and in Mexico, in 2007. The following congress will gather in Nicaragua, in 2011.
